



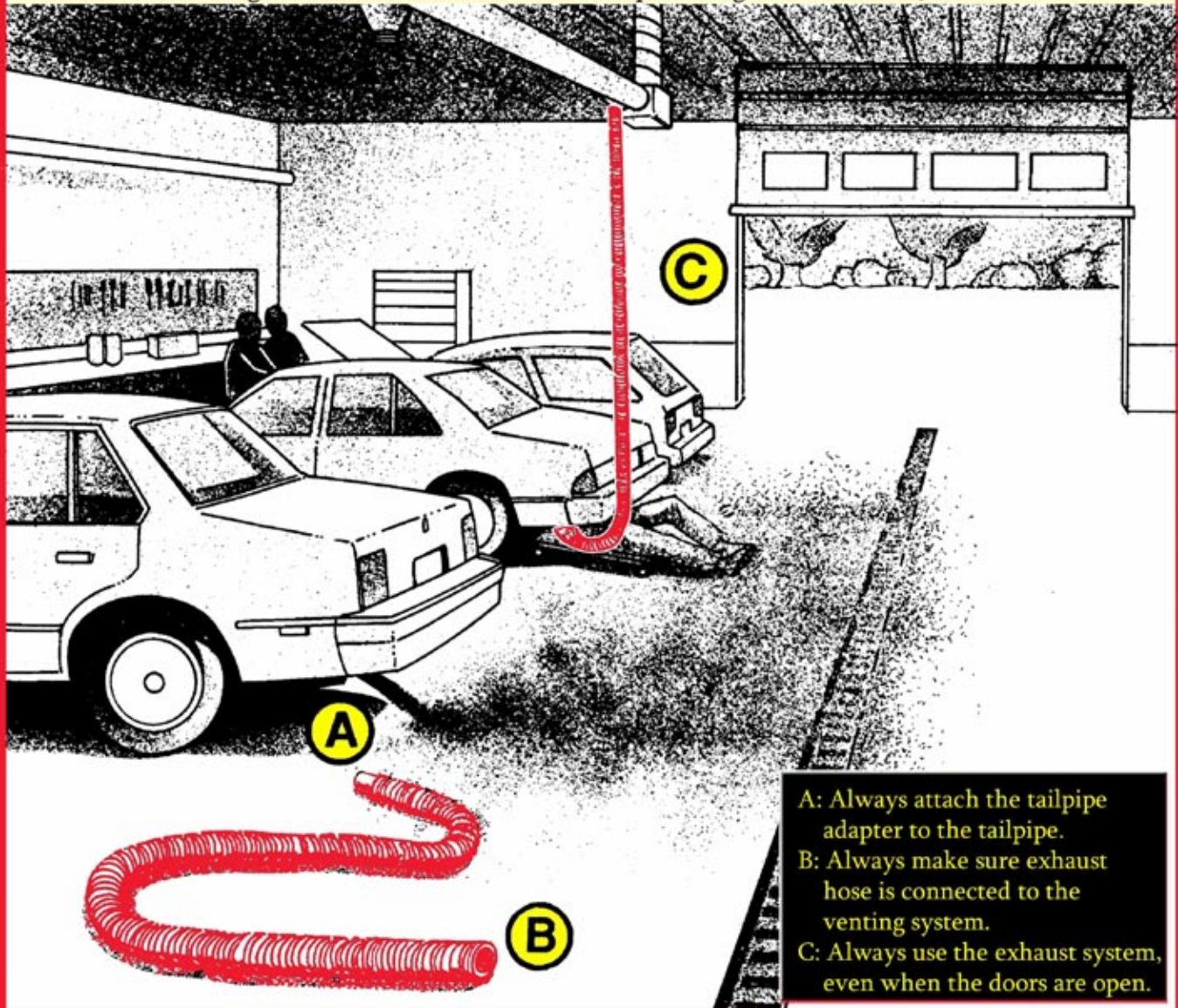

The Dangers of Carbon Monoxide

"Carbon Monoxide from car exhausts and cigarette smoking is an odorless, colorless gas that reduces the oxygen-carrying capacity of the blood. It's effects are first felt in those tissues most sensitive to a lack of oxygen, such as the brain and the heart. Early symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning include headache, followed by weakness, dizziness, dim vision, nausea, and vomiting. At high concentrations, coma and death may result."

- A: Always attach the tailpipe adapter to the tailpipe.
- B: Always make sure exhaust hose is connected to the venting system.
- C: Always use the exhaust system, even when the doors are open.
